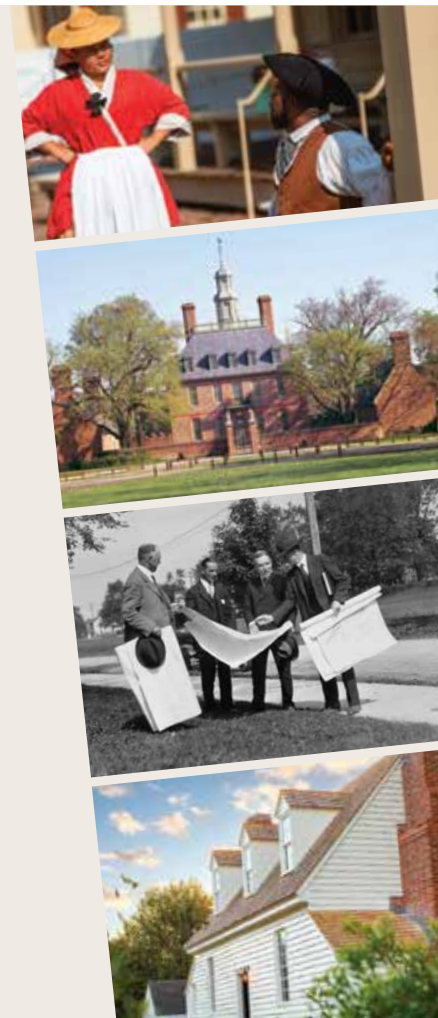

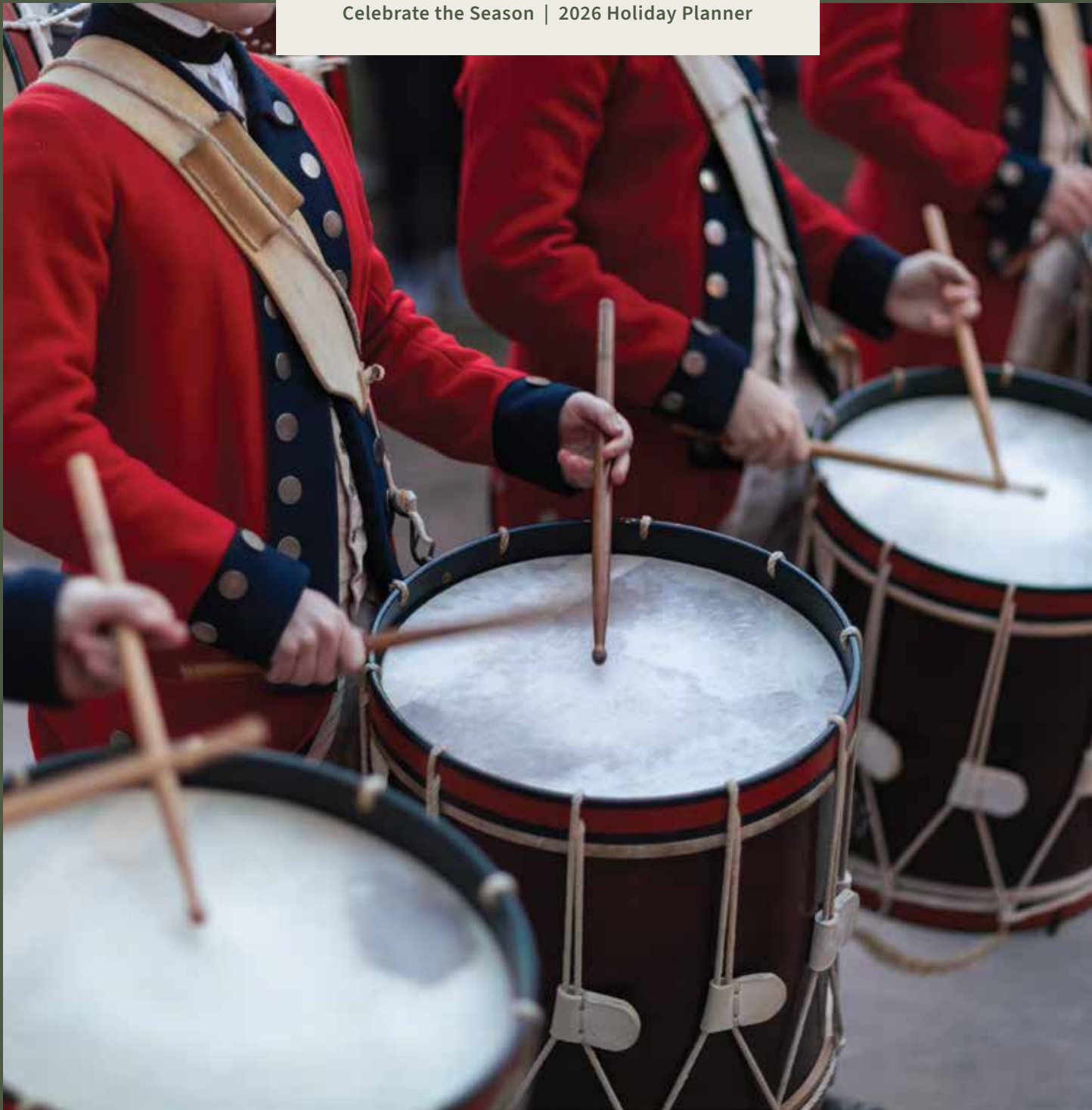

In the 1770s, Williamsburg's citizens developed an increasing interest in folk music overseas. Scottish songs, often in a pastoral setting, fostered a hope for peace that became increasingly rare throughout the decade.
